Hot Topics in Supply Chain: Business and Human Rights, and Forced/Child Labor



We will discuss the important relationship between business practices and human rights through a critical lens which will examine the legal framework for the roles and responsibilities of businesses in regards to human rights. Discussions featuring human rights attorneys focused on cross-border transactions will center around the global regulations and accountability for businesses in their effect on the protection, or lack of protection, of human rights.

We will also discuss Forced labor and Withhold Release Orders (WRO): Measures to Avoid WROs and Obtain Modifications/Revocations.
